### BT Infinity in Boxted

Some parts of Boxted village have access to BT Infinity whilst others do not. A new BT infinity cabinet has been installed opposite the playing fields in Cage Lane with the result that residents who live (approximately) north of the British Legion are able to have BT Infinity. Residents who live south of the British Legion cannot get BT Infinity. These Residents are connected to the telephone cabinet positioned on Straight Road adjacent to Horkesley Road.

Bizarrely during the summer fibre cable was laid from Horkesly Exchange on Ivy Lodge Lane which passed the Straight Road/Horkesley Road telephone cabinet to the new cabinet in Cage lane. Clearly it would not take much to link this cabinet to be able to accept BT Infinity. What is needed is for Boxted residents to register their interest for BT Infinity.
