COLCHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL ELECTION, 5 MAY 2016

From Councillor Nigel Chapman



I have been asked by several villagers to explain about the 'all out' Council election this year....so here goes! Every few years the Boundary Commission reviews the electoral arrangements in councils to ensure representation across their areas is fair and equal and changes in population numbers are reflected in the electoral wards. Colchester Borough Council's review comes into effect in May when the whole council will be elected. This time it has been agreed that the number of councillors will be reduced from 60 to 51, saving over £50,000 of taxpayers money annually. Each ward will be represented by 3 councillors instead of the 1, 2 or 3 as at present. This results in the number of wards being reduced from 27 to 17.

In the rural areas, parishes are the building blocks of the new wards. Langham and Boxted are in the new Rural North Ward, together with Dedham, Fordham, Great Horkesley, Little Horkesley, Wormingford, Great Tey, Chappel, Wakes Colne and Mount Bures. Quite an area!

Voters should remember that they may vote for up to three candidates in the May Borough Council election.

LANGHAM WI

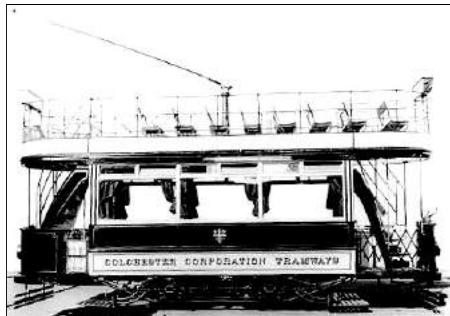

BOXTED PARISH COUNCIL: BUDGET & PRECEPT 2016-2017

From Denise Humphris, Clerk to the Council

The Parish Council are expecting to spend in the region of £37,520 in the 2016/2017 financial year. Last year we used £20,000 of our reserves to keep the increase in the Parish Council precept to a minimum (10% for a Band D taxpayer). We knew then that our forecast expenditure was going to be greater than our income, i.e. future increases would be unavoidable. Since then, we have taken on the additional responsibility of the Sports and Social Club building, which has depleted Parish Council reserves further. Also, the annual support grant from Colchester Borough Council has been reduced by a further 10% this year. This has unfortunately resulted in a shortfall of around £15,000 between expenditure and income, which can no longer be filled by reserves. It was therefore **RESOLVED (unanimously)** to approve the proposed budget (see Appendix B) which means an increase of

approximately £1.59 per month to £59.48 per month for a Band D taxpayer; this represents an overall annual increase of 47%.

Councillors also resolved to review all operations with a view to reducing costs as much as possible, to reduce the likelihood of further future increases. Things which will be considered include the provision of grass cutting services and the maintenance of machinery and lawnmowers owned by the Council. Additional income streams from the Sports and Social Club are also being explored, with the ultimate aim of making the building self financing.

It was further **RESOLVED (unanimously)** that the annual payments from the three sports clubs using the Sports and Social Club building should be increased by 2.5% for April 2016 – April 2017 increasing their monthly payments to £250 per month.
