COLCHESTER BOROUGH LOCAL PLAN

When finally approved by the Secretary of State, Colchester's Local Plan will constitute the strategy for the growth of the Borough, setting out what development will take place up to 2032 and beyond. The next stage in the creation of the Local Plan is the publication of the Colchester Borough Council's (CBC) "Preferred Options", due by 24 June. The Preferred Options will be discussed by the CBC's Local Plan Committee on 5 July (6 pm at the Moot Hall). The CBC will then undertake public consultation on its proposals in July and August. BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

Jonathan Jukes, the Curator of the Marks Hall Estate near Coggeshall, gave a most interesting illustrated talk on the estate at the May meeting.

Recorded in the Domesday Book as *Mercheshala*, the estate has since had comparatively few owners. In the 17th century it was acquired by the Honeywood family, holders of land in Kent and the North, and in 1898 by Welsh MP Thomas Phillips Price. Price died in 1932, bequeathing Marks Hall to Kew Gardens.

In WW2 the estate became the headquarters and utility site for the Earls Colne airfield; the mansion and gardens fell into disrepair and the house was subsequently demolished.

After the death of Price's widow in 1966, Kew Gardens set up a charitable trust to manage the estate and under its care the gardens have been much restored and developed; the walled garden in particular, one of the largest in England, has been reinstated. The trust, funded by charges to visitors and events (www.markshall.org.uk), plant sales and rents from tenant farmers, provides substantial support to Kew Gardens in the latter's plant research and development programmes.

The History Group will be visiting Marks Hall in September.
