BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

Roger Clark, farrier, farmer and leading authority on heavy horses (particularly Suffolk Punches) spoke entertainingly of his "Customers and Other Animals" at the History Group's March meeting. His father was a horse doctor at Ipswich in the 1920s and he could not recall a time when he was not entirely surrounded by horses, having his own pony when three years old.



His wide-ranging reminiscences encompassed the very extensive use of horses as the principal motive power up to WW2 and beyond: as late as 1968 the Saxmundham refuse cart was horse-drawn. Indeed, pack-horses are still retained in some countries. His talk, supported by a display of photographs, elicited many questions from his audience, as well as a number of individual recollections.
