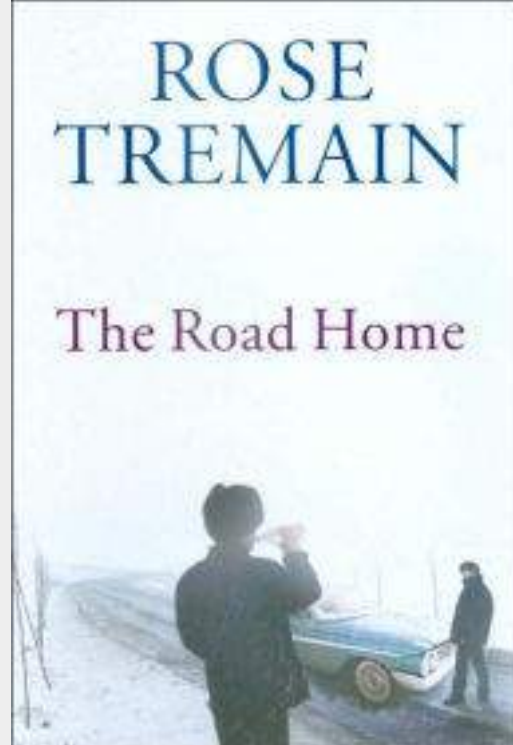


Boxted St Peter's Primary School Governors are very pleased to announce that Mrs Laura Khine, pictured above, will take up the post of Head in January 2016.
