Horse racing and Bingo Night Saturday 21 November from 7 pm. All welcome.



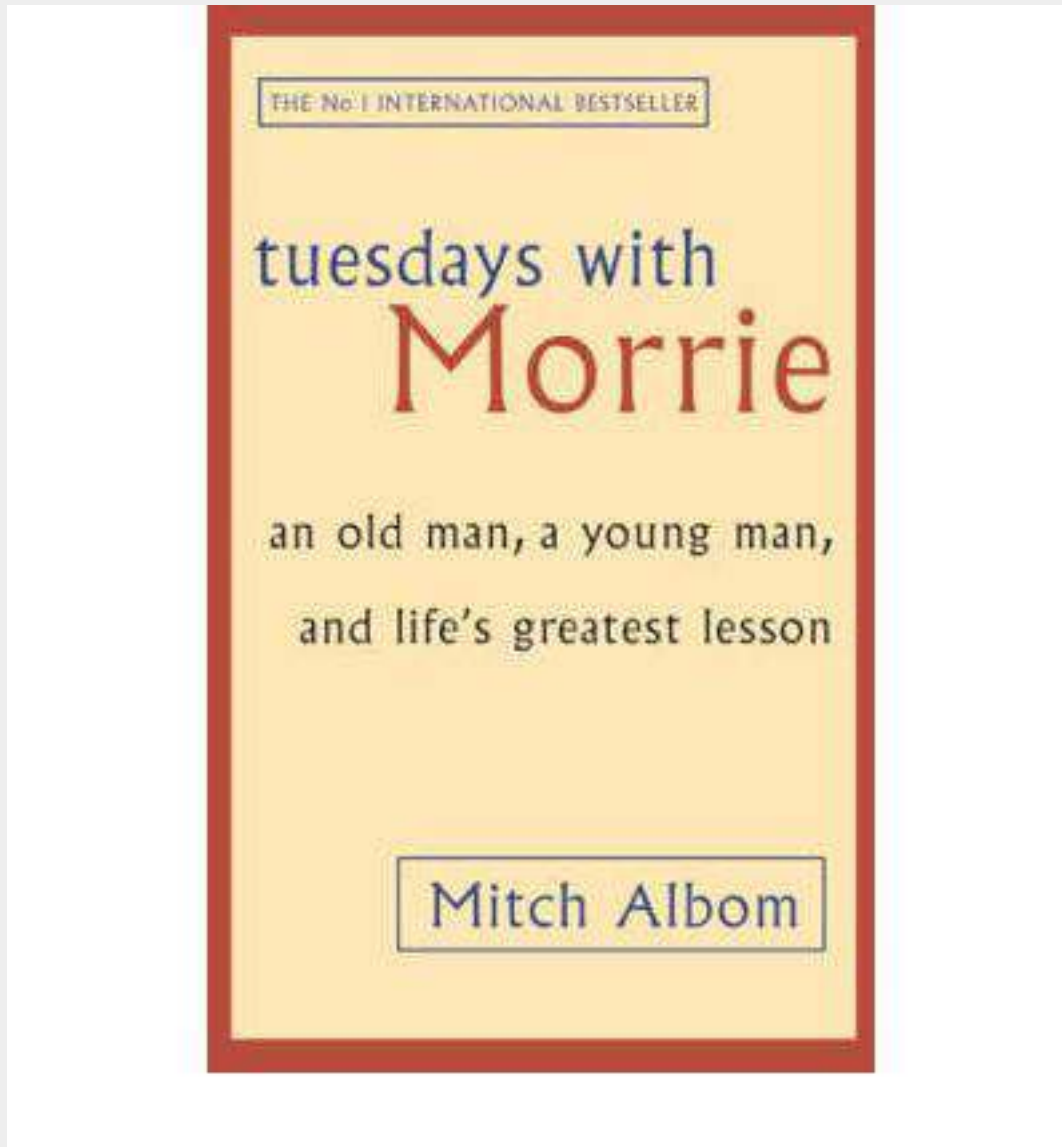
Recent dedication of a new flagpole on Langham Church Tower in memory of the late Wilf Tolhurst.
