Sports and Social Club

Ladies football team have donated a First Aid kit to the Village Hall to compensate for the kit that disappeared after use by Cricket and Men's football.

Removal of all items – clubs have moved all items from the Sports Pavilion and off site. We are waiting for Cricket Club to move fridges and cricket matting and they have been informed that the building can not re-open until they are gone.

Portaloo – permission has been given for a temporary portaloo in the Car Park pending re-opening of the building.
