A MAKEOVER FOR ST MARY'S?

Our two parish churches have experienced many alterations and restorations over the centuries. The Chelmsford Chronicle of 6 November 1863 reports one of them.

RESTORATION OF LANGHAM CHURCH. —This parish church has been re-opened after being entirely restored. The tower, which was in a dangerous state, has been made good with new stone windows in place of brick, stone quoins, rubble facing, &c.

The roof of the nave has been thrown open and re-tiled, and a new open roof cove red with lead was put on the south aisle, a new roof fixed in chancel, divided into panels with mouldings and carved oak bosses.

All the stone windows have been completely restored and reglazed: the whole church re-seated, over 90 additional sittings being obtained. The seating of the chancel has been formed out of the old oak seating, with carved poppy heads, and there are new pulpit, reading desk, altar rail, and font, all to accord with the date of the church. The floor is paved with terra-metallic tiles, and heated on Mitchell's principle. There are also two new porches.

The works (which were under the direction of H.W. Hayward, Esq., of Colchester, the architect employed by the committee) have been done in a very satisfactory manner by Mr. Hawkins, of Monks Eleigh, Suffolk, and Mr. Bretner, mason, of Colchester, who also did the glazing.

It should be added that it is entirely owing to the unwearied exertions of the rector, the Rev. E.C. Ellis, that so much has been accomplished.

COMMUNITY FIRST RESPONDERS

CFR's are trained volunteers who are dispatched by the ambulance service to life threatening emergencies in local communities.

The volunteers normally work within a radius of 8 minutes drive from their location but depending on circumstances this could be further. They can normally get to a casualty before an ambulance can get there, assess the patient and start possible life saving treatment immediately. If the situation changes the CFR can update Ambulance Control to give them an updated assessment of the patient.

The Langham and Boxted areas are covered by a CFR bag supplied by Stratford St Mary Parish Council. This bag is presently used by two volunteers in Stratford St Mary and one in Langham. The area is also covered by other volunteers with different bags from Dedham, East Bergholt, Manningtree, Brantham and Bradfield.

A volunteer can be in call when ever they want, if you are logged off duty, you do not get called.

At the moment the Stratford St Mary bag is not utilised as much as it could be and I would like to improve this. Ideally I would like some volunteers in Langham to complete the training and then become CFR for Langham and the surrounding villages. The more hours we have the bag active the better cover we have for ourselves.

BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

At February's meeting a large number of members and guests welcomed back Peter Jones who this time gave an interesting and well-illustrated talk on 'The Great Essex Earthquake'.

He began with a short simplified explanation of the Earth's structure, why earthquakes occur and just how unpredictable they are.

The Essex event occurred on the morning of 22nd April 1884 at 9.20am. Although the epi-centre was in the vicinity of Peldon and Abberton the shock waves were felt over an area of 53,000 square miles. Consequently it was widely reported in the national newspapers.

There were many witnesses, some of whom ran into the streets fearing for their lives on hearing a loud roaring noise approaching.

At the time the Richter scale for measuring the magnitude of earthquakes had not been invented but it is now estimated that this one was in the order of 5.2.

Extensive damage was caused in the Hythe area and Dutch Quarter of Colchester as well as in numerous surrounding villages. Smaller buildings (usually timber framed) just moved up and down in waves but larger, taller ones such as churches sustained more serious damage.

Surprisingly there are few historical records or memorials of the event.
